When **Isobel Mills** visited **Travis & Company** as a young girl, she had no idea that one day her textiles would be a part of the lauded brand's fine fabrics collection. "Although I didn't have the dream of becoming a fabric designer at the time, I knew I loved what I saw and wanted to be a part of that world," says Mills. Her passion for textile design and art stems from her love of ceramics, and the infinite possibilities that clay's malleability provided. Once she realized that fabric held similar properties—"fabric, like clay, can be manipulated in numerous ways, and I could design and color the material too," she says—the Atlanta native's business took off, with showroom representation in New York; Los Angeles; Austin, Texas; Hollywood, Fla.; and, of course, Atlanta. Mills designs her textiles by mixing stylized structure with an organic flow, using color to craft a visual texture. BALANCING ACT

Partners in business and life, interior designers Jason Dunn and Michael Peters of 2 Gays & a Design are "fabu-lizing" spaces all across metro Atlanta. Here's how they get it done.

For Jason Dunn and Michael Peters of **2 Gays & a Design** (2gaysdesign.com), mixing business with pleasure is their personal key to success in the interiors world. Together, the pair—they've been married for 15 years!—brings their balanced expertise to a long list of clients. Of course, we had to get their exclusive secrets.

WOULD YOU SAY YOU'RE KNOWN FOR A SPECIFIC AESTHETIC?

JD: Our motto is we spend your money like it is our own. We are not trying to be that designer who wants to create a cover page look; we connect with clients and understand their needs.

ANY AREAS WHERE YOUR TASTES DIFFER?

JD: Overall, our aesthetic is transitional. My personal favorite design is seeing concrete floors, but with a 14th-century mirror—mixing different styles. I love walking into a clean room and not feeling like I am going to get sick of it in six months.
MP: I like clean lines and a more contemporary feel. I think that is where we balance each, working with clients to give them a transitional feel.

WHAT'S THE BEST THING ABOUT WORKING WITH YOUR SIGNIFICANT OTHER?

MP: The opportunity to be creative with your spouse. It is so rewarding to create something together in someone's home that they are going to be enjoying for years and years.
JD: My favorite thing is the entire process, start to finish, with a client. We learn something new about each other with every client we get. It is a very emotional process, and we balance each other out. I tend to want to go out on a limb with design, and he pulls me back within reason.

THE MOST CHALLENGING PART?

MP: It is hard to turn it off. We are always talking about, 'Oh, this is going great,' or, 'Oh, this is going really bad.'
JD: I agree. We wake up at three in the morning thinking about all the little details! The hardest is staying emotionally and mentally healthy.

WHAT IS THE KEY TO A SUCCESSFUL BUSINESS RELATIONSHIP?

JD: I know it is cliché, but communication is so important. Don't let things build up if there is something frustrating one person or both; it is important to convey those thoughts and feelings as you have them.

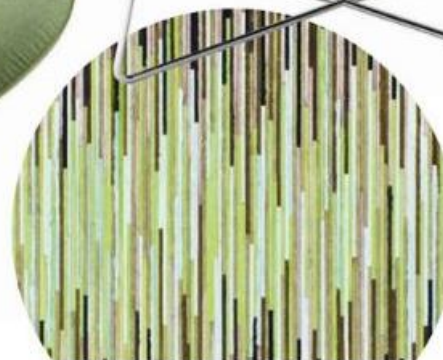
