

# ADAC BUILDING UPDATE

Dear ADAC Design Community,

As our country begins to reopen, we too at ADAC are moving forward in our reopening progression and will move to Phase 2 – Open Daily Access at ADAC effective June 15, 2020.

This next phase is part of our thorough TogetherSafely Master Plan shared earlier this week. This plan has been developed following recommendations of government and health experts and will continue to be monitored and updated as needed on our website TogetherSafely.com.

We know that everyone in our industries – designers, retailers, vendors, sales reps – is eager to open for business and begin working towards economic recovery. And so are we! That said, the process of reopening our buildings is complex and must be undertaken responsibly with the health and safety of our collective team members, customers, and community in mind.

Effective June 15, 2020, we will open ADAC for open daily access with the following guidelines in place in accordance with basic operating requirements for safe hygiene and social distancing to ensure the health and safety of all constituents.

- Temperature checks will be required for all customers and showroom partners upon arrival at the building. Anyone with a recorded temperature in excess of 100.4 ° F will not be granted access to the building.
- All customers and showroom partners must wear an approved personal protective mask at all times throughout the building and in their showrooms while in the presence of others. If a designer or client arrives at our campus without a mask, they will be issued one by ADAC. Customers without masks will not be granted access.
- Access points to our campuses will be limited to monitor traffic and conduct temperature checks. Below are entry points to ADAC during Phase 2:
  - Main entrance of ADAC
  - The Pedestrian Gate at the Loading Dock
- All showrooms are expected to monitor and manage the activity in their showrooms for compliance with safe distancing, prescribed occupancy restrictions, use of PPE, and cleaning protocols.

In the event of any changes to guidance from the State, we will reevaluate and recommunicate our policy. Thank you for your support as we navigate these steps together. We are so glad to be able to welcome you back to ADAC.
