The Hungry Peach focuses on fresh ingredients and sources locally grown food as much as possible for its delectable sandwiches, salads and soups. New additions include a fried green tomato pimento cheese stack, the peachy BLT with candied bacon and peach jam, and green eggs & ham which is topped with a mouth-watering bacon jam. An in-house baker turns out the eatery's freshly baked cookies, cakes and their unforgettable brownies. Soon, guests will be able to enjoy a glass of wine or a mimosa when the eatery receives its liquor license.

To get things running after temporarily closing, the Moores brought on restaurant consultant David Abes of DASH Hospitality Group and director of operations Melina Bischoff. "We found ourselves holding the keys to The Hungry Peach and trying to navigate that while also raising three small children and working full-time jobs," adds Andrew. The Moores credit Abes and Bischoff with enabling them to reopen successfully.

During an extensive redesign, new tables, chairs, countertops and lighting fixtures were added. "We are really going for a homey comfortable feel," says Andrew. "We softened the lighting and revamped the interior look." Kelly's artwork hangs on the walls and she has created an artists' market where guests can purchase silk scarves, beadwork, local candles and more.

The cafe specializes in catering for lunch meetings, conferences and social events. Their bestselling item—the truffle brownie—can also be found at Lucy's Market in Buckhead along with other gourmet signature items.

The café is following CDC and EPA guidelines including table spacing, touchless hand sanitizer, and cleaning and disinfecting methods. ADAC security administers temperature checks and mask requirements for all employees, staff and guests upon entering the premises.
